Directional studs in the pavement show the route of the trail. Follow the plume on the Roman's helmet.

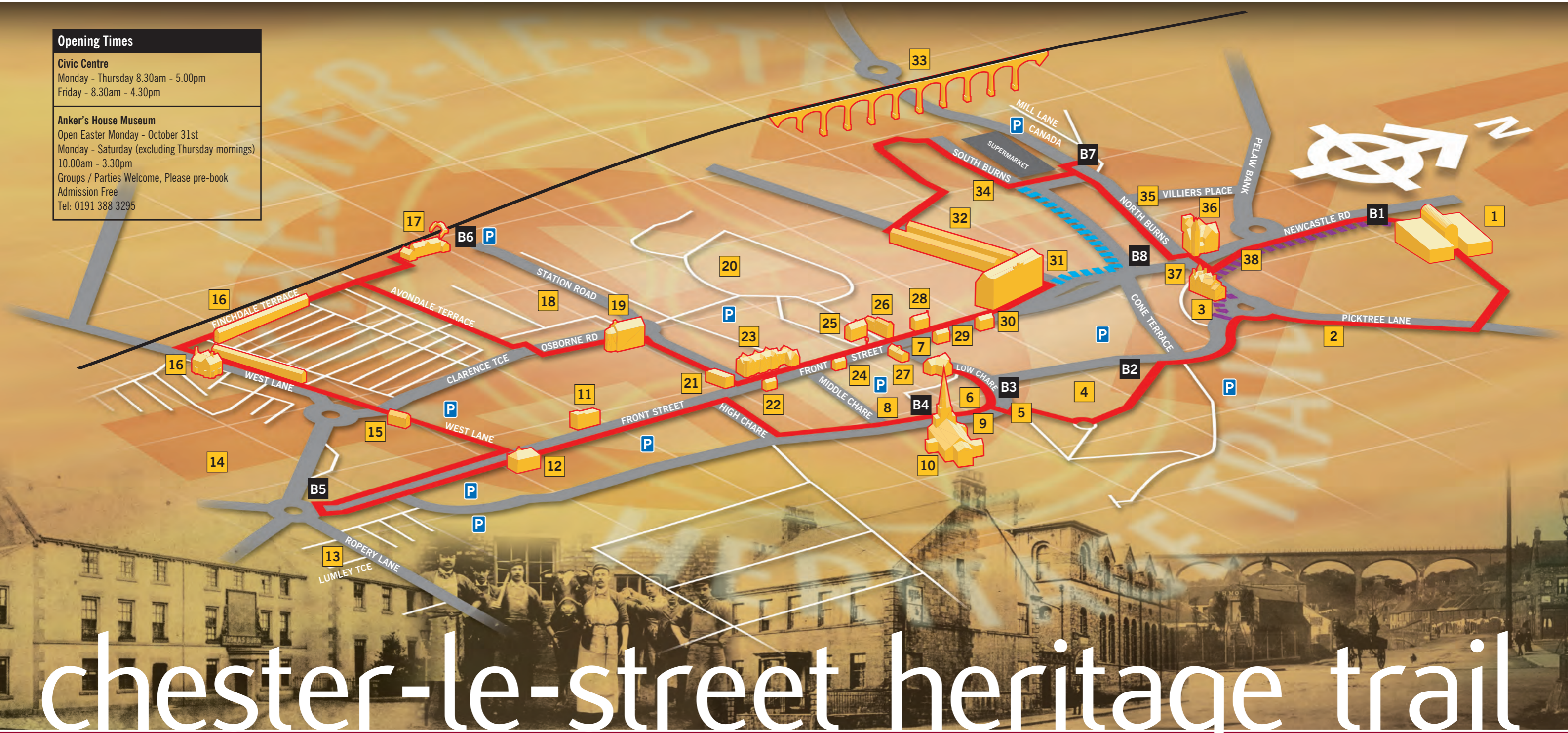
